# What are we learning in the nursery this term?

- As we move into Autumn/Winter seasons the children will be busy learning how to become responsible citizens by taking responsibility to dress appropriately for playing outdoors and walks in the local community. The children have shown very good awareness of how to be kind to their peers and support others when help is needed.
- Our current topic is 'Bridges' as there has been lots of discussions of the different styles of bridges, how they are made and who can use them. This link is now leading into our upcoming topic 'People who help us'. Throughout our 'bridges' topic, the children have been developing their sharing and problem solving skills as they have worked together to create their own bridges.

#### Sickness, Diarrhea and Rashes

In the interest of Health and Hygiene, to prevent germs and bugs spreading, please be aware that should your child have a sickness and/or diarrhea bug, they should not return to Nursery until 48 hours after all symptoms have stopped.

If your child has developed a rash or spots, please seek a diagnosis and/or speak to a member of staff before attending the nursery.
