FHPC work alongside the school to increase your young learner's attainment, achievement and experiences. FHPC have had many successes in recent years:

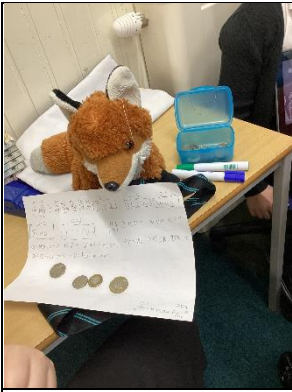
- Funding P1 gifts, P7 hoodies and Easter treats.
