We have had an energetic start to the year 2025, Mrs Gunning and I have been out in classrooms carrying out observations and we have been impressed with the learning and teaching on show at Falla Hill.

We have seen Problem solving using multiplication and division in P7. The learning of how to calculate volume in P6. P5 learning spelling patterns and spelling rules. In P5/4, P4, P3 & P2 they were writing and planning writing – with some excellent reports produced. Also in P4 the children were learning about the different emergency services and explaining their role, we also saw P3 learning about onomatopoeia – P2/1 were learning about numbers and calculations and in P1 they were working on their letter sounds. All in all another busy week.

Nursery

Our children who are starting school in August took part in lots of activities this week. On Tuesday they took part in a STEAM activity, looking at what our planet is made from, and on Wednesday they enjoyed shadow and peg experiments as part of the CREST Project.

All of the children in nursery enjoyed Chinese New Year celebrations where they had the opportunity to taste some Chinese food. They also enjoyed singing some Chinese songs and discussing the Chinese culture.
